00 – CDEP Management Committee Local Law 2007	<p>The objects of this local law are to—</p> <p>(a) Provide for the establishment and operation of a local services committee to manage Council’s CDEP scheme; and</p> <p>(b) provide for the scope of powers that may be delegated by resolution to the committee.</p>		
00 – Housing Management Committee Local Law 2007	<p>The objects of this local law are to—</p> <p>(a) provide for the establishment and operation of a local services committee to manage community housing; and</p> <p>(b) provide for the scope of powers that may be delegated by resolution to the committee and set out other functions of the committee.</p>		
01 – Administration	<p>The object of this local law is to provide a legal framework for the administration, implementation and enforcement of the Council’s local laws.</p>		
02 – Law and Order	<p>The object of this local law is to provide a legal framework for the enforcement of law and order in the area governed by Council.</p>		
03 – Keeping and Control of Animals	<p>The objects of this local law are to regulate the keeping of animals -</p> <p>(a) to protect the community against risk of injury and damage; and</p> <p>(b) to ensure that animals do not create a nuisance, or a hazard to health or safety; and</p> <p>(c) to prevent pollution and other environmental damage resulting from the keeping of animals; and</p> <p>(d) to protect the amenity of the local environment; and</p> <p>(e) to ensure that animals are kept and used in a way that is consistent with the rights and expectations of the local community.</p>

04 – Control of Nuisances	<p>The objects of this local law are to protect the environment, and public health, safety and convenience, by eliminating or reducing nuisances resulting from -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) activities in public places; and (b) excessive noise; and (c) the threat of injury; and (d) smoke, other atmospheric pollutants, and wind-borne materials; and (e) vegetation overgrowth; and (f) visual pollution resulting from unsightly accumulations of objects and materials. 		
05 – Roads	<p>The objects of this local law are to –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) ensure that the Council has the necessary powers to construct, maintain and improve roads within its area; and (b) provide for the naming of roads and the numbering of adjacent properties; and (c) ensure that roads and associated structures and vegetation are in harmony with their natural and built environment; and (d) regulate the use of roads, including parking, prevent nuisances and interference with the safe movement of traffic. 		
06 – Land and Natural Resource Management	<p>The objects of this local law are to –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) regulate access by non-residents to sites of traditional or cultural significance; (b) protect sites of traditional or cultural significance; and (c) regulate camping in the area governed by Council.

Repealing Local Laws No. 1 (Miscellaneous Local Laws) 2015	<p>The object of this local law is to repeal the following local laws -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) 00- CDEP Management Committee Local Law 2007;and (b) 00 – Housing Management Committee Local Law; and (c) 01 - Administration; and (d) 02 – Law and Order; and (e) 03 – Keeping and Control of Animals; and (f) 04 – Control of Nuisances; and (g) 05 – Roads; and (h) 06 – Land and Natural Resource Management. 		
Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2015	<p>The purposes of this local law are to provide a legal and procedural framework for the administration, implementation and enforcement of the local government’s local laws, subordinate local laws and specified regulatory powers under legislation, and to provide for miscellaneous administrative matters.</p>		
Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2015	<p>The purpose of this local law is to regulate and manage the keeping and control of animals in the local government’s area in a way that—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) balances community expectations with the rights of individuals; and (b) protects the community against risks to health and safety; and (c) prevents pollution and other environmental damage; and (d) protects the amenity of the local community and environment. 		
Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2015	<p>The purpose of this local law is to protect the environment and public health, safety and amenity within the local government’s area.</p>		
Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2015	<p>The purpose of this local law is to—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) protect the health and safety of persons using local government controlled land, facilities, infrastructure and roads; and (b) preserve features of the natural and built environment and other

Local Law No 5. (Parking) 2015	The purpose of this local law is to complement the regulated parking provisions in chapter 5, part 6 of the TORUM Act by providing for the exercise of local government powers authorised under that Act.		
Local Law No. 7 (Indigenous Community Land Management) 2015	The purpose of this local law is to enable local governments that have jurisdiction over trust areas under the <i>Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Communities (Justice, Land and Other Matters) Act 1984</i> to regulate the use of these areas.
